HOW TO APPLY

- All 8th grade applicants must register for and take the STVM Scholarship/Placement Test, offered in the fall of 8th grade.
- Parents/Guardians are asked to send this completed application to Admissions Office, St. Vincent-St. Mary High School, 15 N Maple St., Akron, OH 44303 by mid-January 2017 in order for your student to be included in our first-round review of applicants. We also require two STVM Teacher Recommendation forms to be completed and returned directly to STVM Admissions. If applicable, please forward a copy of your student's current IEP/ETR and any Special Education records by December 1, 2016 for our review. Upon receipt of application materials, STVM will fax your student's current school for 7th/8th grade records (grades, attendance, behavior, and standardized test scores).
- Our Admissions Committee will send letters of acceptance or non-acceptance during the month of February 2017 or later.
