

After Prom FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions)

Q: What is After Prom?

A: After Prom is an event that is held the same night as the Prom. It begins immediately following the conclusion of Prom and is a safe, supervised and fun night for our students.

Q: As a STVM student, do I have to attend Prom in order to be able to attend After Prom?

A: All STVM ***junior and senior students*** who are in good standing but have chosen not to attend Prom **are allowed and are encouraged to attend After Prom.**

Q: When is After Prom?

A: It begins Saturday, May 6, 2017 at 11:00 p.m. and ends on Sunday, May 7, 2017 at 2:00 a.m.

Q: Where is After Prom being held?

A: After Prom is being held at the Cleveland Clinic Akron General Health & Wellness Center in Bath/Akron Ohio 44333 - 4125 Medina Rd (Rt. 18). **Yes, there will be swimming here!**

Q: Who puts on After Prom?

A: The After Prom event is not a school-funded event. Instead, it is sponsored by Parents' Club and the many volunteers/parents throughout our community.

Q: How can I help?

A: Whether you're a student or a parent/volunteer, you can help by spreading the word about After Prom, encouraging your friends to attend and by getting involved with the After Prom committee. Consider making a donation of at least \$10 or increments of \$10 in cash/check or gift cards, so that we can give each student a goodie bag at the end of the night.

Q: Will my parents be at After Prom?

A: It's possible that some of the attendee's parents will be there as volunteer workers that night. Besides those volunteer workers, no other parents will be present for the event.

Q: How do I get to After Prom? Is transportation to/from After Prom available or provided?

A: There is no organized transportation provided for After Prom. It's a relatively short 15 minute drive (about 7 miles) from the Todaro's Party Center. You might want to check with your friends and classmates about carpooling there together. Although there are different ways to get there, a simple way would be to take Merriman Rd to Smith Rd. to W.Market St. - The After Prom location is just past the Rt. 77 expressway on W.Market/Rt.18/Medina Rd.

Q: What time do I arrive at the After Prom event?

A: **Check-in for the After Prom** begins at 10:30 p.m. and ends at 11:30 p.m. If you aren't attending Prom, come as early as 10:30 p.m. If you're going to Prom, you just need to be sure that you arrive for check-in to the event **no later than 11:30 p.m.** No attendee will be admitted to the event after 11:30 p.m.—no exceptions! If you do not arrive by 11:30 p.m., we will be contacting your parents.

Q: If I want to leave the After Prom event prior to the 2:00 a.m. end time, will I be allowed to leave?

A: The committee is planning so many fun activities in hopes that all of the attendees will want to stay for the entire event. We encourage everyone to stay and will be giving out the best prizes last—**you must be present to win!** On the off-chance that you do want (or need) to leave early

from the After Prom event, we do have an early check out procedure. Note: GUESTS must arrive and leave at the same time as their STVM ESCORT. We will need to contact your Parents' before we hand you the early release form and allow you to leave.

Q: Is there a separate permission form and cost to attend After Prom?

A: Yes. Because After Prom is separate from Prom, there is also a separate permission form that's required. All of the forms for After Prom are going to be available on the Parents' Club website (in the "forms" section) as well as in the Bookstore. The cost to attend After Prom is just \$10.00 per attendee.

Q: How do I pay for After Prom?

A: All After Prom attendees must submit the required After Prom permission form along with either \$10 cash or check payment (**made payable to STVM Parents' Club**) before the **Friday, April 28, 2017 at 1:00pm** deadline to the Bookstore. Both the form and the payment must be turned in by this deadline.

Q: Do I need to bring anything with me to After Prom?

A: If you're able to change into **comfortable clothes** before arriving at After Prom by 11:30p.m., you can do so. If you're coming directly from Prom, you will want to bring a change of comfortable clothing and shoes with you. You'll be able to change clothes and bag/tag your formal wear at After Prom. Also, if you are planning on swimming at the After Prom, you will need proper swim attire and towels.

Q: Is there a dress code for After Prom?

A: Yes. Parents' Club supports STVM's dress and behavior codes so all clothing must be modest and appropriate for a Catholic young person. Therefore, no tube tops, bare midriffs, or otherwise revealing clothing. T-shirts, shorts, sweat pants, sandals, flip-flops and tennis shoes are the perfect casual attire for After Prom.

Q: Will there be food and drink provided at After Prom?

A: Yes!! There will be plenty of food and drinks provided to After Prom attendees all throughout the entire event. There is no additional cost to attendees for the food or the drinks.

Q: Can I bring my own food, water, or beverages into the After Prom event?

A: No. In order to maintain the security and safety of all After Prom attendees, you are not allowed to bring in any food, water, beverages or cups/glasses/bottles. All bags, coats, etc. will be subject to search upon entering After Prom.

Q: If I forgot something in my car or want to take something out to my car, will I be allowed to go out to the parking lot during After Prom?

A: No. None of the attendees are allowed to leave and then re-enter the After Prom event. This is a safety/security concern that we take very seriously. Please make sure you double-check and bring everything you will need prior to entering the AfterProm facility.

Q: If I sign up and pay to attend After Prom but then later decide that I can't or don't want to attend, will I get a refund of my \$10.00?

A: Sorry, but no. Because we'll have already planned on prizes, food, drinks, etc. from all registered attendees, no refunds will be issued.
